HISTORIC CANTON CHURCH

Visiting the Canton Church is taking a step back to the early history of Montana. It was built at the town of Canton, now under Canyon Ferry Lake, in the 1870's. Canton Church was moved to higher ground in 1954 and operated as a Catholic mission church until the early 1980's. The church was restored and renovated through the efforts of local community members and interested parties beginning in 1997. It remains as the 2nd oldest standing Catholic church building in the State of Montana.

The church now hosts tours along with free musical and historical performances during the summer months. The church is open June – August every other Friday 3-6 p.m. The grounds of the church are always open. Family picnics or other outdoor events can be held in the church park, across from the church.

The church is located on the east side of Canyon Ferry Lake 9 miles North of Townsend, Montana on Highway 284.
